Organization description

Philips currently holds about 80,000 patent rights, 26,000 trademark registrations, 15,000 design registrations and some 1,600-domain name registrations.

This large IPR portfolio is used to support the Philips product divisions in achieving their business goals. In addition, IP&S actively seeks opportunities to license Philips' technologies to third parties, by which technologies can be shared with many partners and be brought to the market place even quicker.

Department description

You will be working within the Business Intelligence department. Within IP&S, this department has 2 focus areas: IP Intelligence and Market Intelligence.

Market Intelligence focuses on providing reliable information on companies, markets and products to IP&S. IP Intelligence focuses on providing reliable added value information on patents, trademarks and designs to Philips. You will be joining 12 colleagues in the IP Intelligence department.

Your core activity will be collecting IP data and transform this into comprehensive, reliable information, which should enable decision makers to make strategic decisions. Your key areas of responsibility will be:
